## MAYORAL AMENDMENT AND EXTENSION OF DECLARATION OF THE CITY OF DILLEY, TEXAS, DECLARING A LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER AND PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of DILLEY on the 17th day of November, 2020, has determined that there is an imminent threat of injury or loss of life or property resulting from:

The novel coronavirus (COVID-19) has been recognized globally as a contagious respiratory virus and there has been an **increase** in cases that have been confirmed in Frio County, Texas and in Texas, and **cases are expected to increase**.

WHEREAS, the City Council of DILLEY has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate and prevent the suffering of people and to protect property; and

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF DILLEY:

That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for DILLEY pursuant to Section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.

Pursuant to Section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of 30 days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Council of the City of DILLEY.

Pursuant to Section 418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.

Pursuant to Section 418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the city emergency management plan.

Pursuant to Section 122.006 of the Health and Safety Code, That this declaration authorizes the City to take any actions necessary to promote health and suppress the virus, including the quarantine of persons and occupied structures, examining and regulating hospitals, regulating ingress and egress from the City, regulating ingress and egress to occupied structures, establishment of quarantine stations, emergency hospitals, and other hospitals, and insuring compliance for those who do not comply with the City's rules,

- 1. City of Dilley Closures. It is ordered as follows: Dilley City Hall Lobby, Dilley Public Library, Police Department Lobby, Municipal Court Lobby, City Park playground equipment, baseball fields & basketball courts shall be closed immediately and remain closed until further notice.
- 2. Daytime Curfew. This declaration hereby implements a citywide daytime curfew for all school age children and juveniles that directly prohibits school age children and juveniles from being out in public places inside the city limits between the hours of

7:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. daily during the duration of this declaration until or unless amended by the City Council. Exception to this curfew includes travel to and from a wifi zone or hotspot in order to complete online school or to and from work/place of employment, and medical facilities.

3. Outside gatherings prohibited. All outside gatherings of 10 or more are hereby cancelled and/or prohibited until further notice. All gatherings given approval by City Council are suspended until further notice and approval is revoked unless this order is lifted prior to the gathering/event date. Please check with the City Secretary for questions on this matter.

This proclamation shall extend the Local State of Disaster Declaration and Public Health Emergency issued on November 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020 and the August 11, 2020 Declaration.

That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its approval by the City Council of the City of DILLEY and shall remain in effect for the next <u>14</u> days, unless revoked or extended by City Council of the City of DILLEY.
