## **ORDINANCE NO. 23-09-28-C**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DILLEY, TEXAS LEVYING AN AD VALOREM TAX FOR THE USE AND BENEFIT OF THE CITY OF DILLEY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING OCTOBER 1, 2023 AND TERMINATING SEPTEMBER 30, 2024.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DILLEY TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That there is hereby levied and there shall be collected for the use and benefit of the City of Dilley, and for the purpose of providing for the interest and sinking fund to retire the principal and interest of the bonded indebtedness of said City for the tax year commencing October 1, 2023 and terminated on September 30, 2024, a tax on all property, real, personal and mixed within the corporate limits of the City of Dilley subject to taxation, a tax of \$0.848012 on each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation of such property.

SECTION 2: That such tax shall be appropriated to the specific purposes hereinafter set forth, to wit:

- 1. <u>\$0.386294</u> for each \$100.00 valuation of property for the Maintenance and Operations of the General Government (General Fund);
- 2. \$\frac{\$0.461718}{}\$ for each \$100 valuation of property for the Interest and Sinking Fund.

<u>SECTION 3:</u> in Accordance with the provisions and requirements of Section 26.065 of the Texas Tax Code as mended, the City of Dilley hereby states:

## THIS TAX RATE WILL NOT INCREASE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.
