



ORDINANCE NO. 15-02-10

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DILLEY, TEXAS REGULATING THE CARRYING OF CONCEALED WEAPONS ON CITY PROPERTY BY CITY EMPLOYEES; AMENDING THE EMPLOYEE HANDBOOK; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FINDING AND DETERMINING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS ORDINANCE IS PASSED IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DILLEY, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the Code of Ordinances and Employee Handbook of the City of Dilley, Texas is amended to read as follows:

(a) City employees, including an employee who holds a license to carry a concealed handgun under Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code, or who otherwise lawfully possesses a firearm, is hereby prohibited from possessing a firearm the employee is otherwise authorized by law to possess on the premises owned, operated or subject to the control by the City of Dilley.

(b) This provision does not prohibit an employee who holds a license to carry a concealed handgun under Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code, who otherwise lawfully possesses a firearm, or who lawfully possesses ammunition from transporting or storing a firearm or ammunition the employee is authorized by law to possess in a locked, privately owned motor vehicle in a parking lot, parking garage, or other parking area the City provides for employees.

(c) In this section, "premises" has the meaning assigned by Section 46.035(f)(3), Penal Code.

Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That if any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of such ordinance shall continue in full force and effect the same as if such invalid or unconstitutional provision had never been a part hereof.

Section 4. That it is the intention of the City Council and is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance shall become and be a part of the Code of Ordinances and Employee Handbook of the City of Dilley, Texas, and that sections of this ordinance may

be renumbered or re-lettered to accomplish such intention.

Section 5. That nothing in this ordinance shall be constructed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or prior ordinance; nor shall any legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this ordinance.

Section 6. That this ordinance shall take effect on February 10, 2015.


