The library has an obligation to protect the health and safety Of its staff and/or Patrons.

- <u>Services at the library</u>: Computers, Faxing, copies etc. will be made <u>by Appointment only</u>.
- Not more than ten patrons in the library at one time.
- Patrons will be required to wear a Mask
- Upon entering the library patrons <u>use hand sanitizer</u>
- Signage has been placed in and around the library for 6-Ft. Social Distancing.
- One hour limit on the computers
- All <u>Returned books will be Quarantined for 72 hours</u>
- No public programs
- No socializing and mingling at the library
- Only one family member is to accompany a child (ages 6-15) that is visiting the library (child must be old enough to wear a mask).
- <u>Cleaning and Disinfecting is mandatory</u> after each patron leaves (computers, remove & replace Keyboard covers, doors, chairs, etc.) <u>for everyone's safety</u>.
